# ICB CERTIFIED COUNSELORS APPLYING FOR THE CODP BOARD REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) Counselors who hold a current certification with ICB can add the CODP Board Registration credential as a specialty area at a reduced cost and condensed completion of the application. The advantages to being an ICB certified counselor and receiving the CODP Board Registration are:

- CODP Biennial Fee \$30.00 Vs \$140.00 (CODP I) or \$160.00 (CODP II)
- Maintenance of CODP Board Registration 10 CEUs (CODP Specific) vs 40 CEUs
- Recognition as a professional working with the COD Population

ICB certified AOD counselors applying for CODP I/II Board Registration will need to complete the CODP Application with the following information:

- 3. Supervised Practical Experience Form Page 6
